Welcome and minutes of last meeting

Karen McMullin welcomed parents to the school council meeting.

MOTION:

It was moved by Cristina Toporas and seconded by Jeny Nussey that the minutes of the school council meeting of September 28, 2017 be approved as presented. The motion was passed unanimously.

Approval of school council by-laws

Karen McMullin noted that the Adam Beck school council by-laws were presented in detail at the September meeting. Due process requires the by-laws be formally approved by motion of the school council executive.

MOTION:

It was moved by Alex Bellamy and seconded by Julie Middleton that the Adam Beck Jr PS School Council by-laws be approved as presented. The motion was passed unanimously.

Principal's report

Mr. Yee introduced Mr. Volpato, new teacher at the school.

Mr. Yee outlined the principal's report. Highlights of his update include:

- Participation of Adam Beck students in Cross Country Meet on October 2, 2017. Congratulations to all
 cross country cross runners and thank you to all parent volunteers.
- Halloween Parade will take place on October 31, preceded by Monster Mash dance in the gym led by Ms. Smith.
- ECO team is developing a "No littering" billboard for the Woodbine Beach Change station
- French immersion registration key dates
 - Application opens: October 30, 2017
 - Deadline for applications: November 30, 2017
- Remembrance Day Assembly will take place on Friday, November 10, 2017 in the gym
- Scholastic book fair is due November 14-17, 2017
- Reminder that all parents who wish to volunteer require a police clearance. Forms are available at the
 office.

Mr. Yee and Ms. Scenna outlined the <u>EQAO results for Adam Beck</u> grade 3 and grade 6 students. Mr. Yee explained the results and provided additional information that the school administration has used to interpret the results. He outlined the learnings and next steps.

Mr. Yee presented the Adam Beck school budget for 2017-2018 school year. He outlined some general considerations that TDSB takes into account when developing annual school budgets, which are outlined on the TDSB website here. Mr. Yee noted that TDSB uses the Learning Opportunity Index (LOI) that TDSB to determine the level of resources each school receives. The LOI indicates the socio-economic status of students enrolled in at Adam Beck – which determines the amount of resources TDSB allocates to our school – is very high compared to other TDSB schools. In 2017, Adam Beck ranks 438th of the 471 schools in TDSB in the Learning Opportunity Index list, where 1st on the list is the school with the greatest level of challenges and thus requiring most resources.

School council budget amendment

Julie Middleton brought forward an amendment to the 2017-2018 budget of the school council (which was approved at the September meeting). The proposed amendment addresses the fact that a significantly higher number of students enrolled in kindergarten in this school year. The budget was developed in May 2017 based on the TDSB's projection of 80 kindergarten students. The actual number of kindergarten students in 2017-2018 school year is 135.

MOTION:

It was moved by Julie Middleton and seconded by Karen McMullin that the 2017-2018 budget of Adam Beck school council be amended as follows: Increase the kindergarten special projects budget from \$1,360 (80 students, \$17/student) to \$2,295 (135 students, \$17/student). The motion was passed unanimously.
