  - Formalizing this year's budget at budget meeting next week.
- Matt gave update on fundraisers and events from last school year which were all profitable those we were able to hold!
- \$41,825 in the bank at this time.
- Normally we'd have a new budget sorted at the end of June in order to start spending in Sept, but with things as they are, we decided to wait until Fall to go through the budget process & determine what we're able to do.
- No fundraisers until at least Nov, but finding ways to support the school & the community.

- All council initiatives are parent-run & we're always looking for new volunteers and ideas.

## **Principal's Report**

Ms Scenna provided updates:

- Thanked parents and students and teachers for their cooperation & excellent compliance
- Mrs. Mavrou new VP welcomed
- Process for return to school & health checks administrators using professional discretion regarding symptoms e.g., runny noses a doctor's note for seasonal allergies is hugely helpful
- PPE provided by the school board is bountiful, prioritizing hand-washing
- Phone calls preferred over emails to the office
- Forms for excursion to be handled physically & cautiously
- 446 in-person school, 81 in virtual school

- Technology not used up during Covid, so we still have ours & board delivered us some more too
- Dividers for tables made by staff working great
- 3-fold plastic dividers purchased & also working well
- Field & playground spray-painted
- Strategic staff placing & cohorts for playing outside scheduled, zoned & time-tabled
- Sept 30: opt-in or out of in-person or virtual school final date email Ms Scenna & cc Barbara Logan
  - this could mean reorganizing classrooms again, not able to satisfy social requests
- All in-school class teachers will have a Google class or Bright Space platform for students just in case we have to move to on-line again
- No visitors allowed yet
- Recess: mask break-time must be outdoors, so ensure students prepared for all weather e.g. boots, umbrellas, rain coats
- Prepared a map provided to staff in the event of a rainy day with indoor lunch
  - \* if rainy and you can bring children home for lunch, please do!
- Staff had 3 days of training before school started
  - Diversity & inclusion survey, anti-black racism, white fragility training
- All staff members complete Covid training by tomorrow
- New math curriculum summarized by Mme Bettas: the government has brought the math curriculum into 2020
  & removed expectations duplicated and added coding & financial literacy
- Question: if everyone ends up going virtual due to society quarantine order would Adam Beck students migrate to remote learning or stay with their current homeroom teacher? Answer: STAY where you are.
- Still trying to hire more teachers for on-line 77,000 virtual students, hired over 2,200 teachers, need about 200 French teachers
- Terry Fox run this year theme "Do it your way" no collecting cash, on-line fundraiser only: walk will take place during phys ed classes
  - on Fri. Oct. 2 we'll have a red & white day in honour of Terry Fox
- Students allowed to play on playground looking into bags for balls, but can't until students keeping their distance properly.
- Students doing great with social distancing outside in the beginning, but slipping now & they need that mask-free time so must work on keeping their "bubble" around them and their "zombie arms"
- Honorary Reese Fallon benches coming
- No photography allowed Grade 6 grad update to come
- Every day the school completes a survey for government regarding absences
- TDSB response plan for Covid to be shared
- Kindergarten entry for Mme J class not fenced-in, so those children will need to be moved
- ALL guests on the property will need to wear a mask, mandatory as of today.
