### 2020-21 Budget and Treasurers' Report

Jeff Jay and Matt Gowing presented budget passed for the year as part of the new process.

- We've trimmed our expectations for fund-raising this year due to the pandemic
- Focus on education enhancement, STEM and pizza lunch repayments
- \$41,655 started the year in the bank
- All fundraising plans are still in development and pivoting to virtual where possible eg. Holiday Party
- Outdoor classroom resources eg. stools

#### **Principal's Report**

Ms Scenna concentrated on communication regarding Anti-Black racism incident at the school to provide further understanding on efforts being made:

- Received advice from Equity and Inclusive Schools group
- Mandatory policy requiring that staff report such incidents
- Our actions will be monitored and supported going forward by the equity professionals and co-facilitating what we do to address this on-going
- A structured, guided process for learning
- No school improvement plan to share right now as we're working with experts to guide us in the most appropriate direction moving forward.
- Rejoin us Nov. 26 where the equity dept will be working with us and sharing individual lived experiences with us
- Protecting and promoting human rights in the school and continuing to reach out to school community with efforts that can also be made in the home.
- Focus will be on age-appropriate education for students and families in the community around discrimination and Anti-Black racism and our identities.
- Ms Scenna took questions from the group: a parent asked about how Covid efforts coming along at school in terms of social distancing and cohorts in zones keeping apart. Family communication to encourage this at home is welcome.
- Mme Bettas mentioned that students getting more comfortable in the classroom and need more reminders
  about distancing and an extra mask every day would be ideal along with indoor shoes welcome and dressing in
  layers
- School has lots of decent available extra masks
- And Happy Birthday to Ms Scenna!
