**STEM:** Check out the recent post from June 6 on the Adam Beck Council Website sharing information around the multiple classes that experienced coding and robotics workshops through ExtraEd.

**Pizza Lunch:** Last pizza lunch had smaller numbers as 2 kindie classes were away. More and more pizza was ordered near the end of year. Older students supported delivering pizzas in groups of two. There was a volunteer for every class for the last pizza lunch. A new lead - Tariq - has stepped up to continue this event.

**Spirit (Blue Jays Update):** Jays game on June 2 and positive feedback was received. DJ Mike is coming next week all day for play day.

## **Treasurer's Update**

Video shared update from Pat re: the last Treasurer's report of the year:

- members to vote tonight on the upcoming school year budget
- 2023-2024 numbers to date were shared with key budget categories

#### **Some Highlights**

- -\$65, 000 resulted from fundraising
- -education enhancement spent close to fully allotted amount (including library revitalization)
- -Ms. Smith's budget spent all of the allotted amount to support Phys. Ed programming
- -Mayfair far exceeded expectations raising \$16, 547
- -pizza lunch raised 23,924 prior to the last pizza lunch (went over budget by around \$2000 likely due to inflation of costs and popularity) Proposing members vote for overage to offset this overage.
- -School garden spent almost all funding provided
- -Visiting artists made excellent use of budget (spent almost entire allotted budget)
- -Mental Well-being spent close to \$5500 budget
- -Equity came in well under budget due to some cancelled initiatives during the year
- -to see other line items, please visit the Adam Beck School Council Website

#### Proposed 2024-2025 Budget

- -2 budget meetings occurred in May where a proposed budget was developed along with fundraising goals
- -standard fundraising line items (ie. Mayfair, Movie Night, etc.) Projected income \$57, 200
- -categories that spend the fundraising budget line for Grade 6 grad \$1500 (no longer including Legacy project)
- -funding visit artists again this coming year
- -will continue donation to another school (10% on net fundraising proceeds) ~\$2527
- -a few new education enhancement line items (\$1500 for decodable books; \$2000 towards a *Science of Reading* program; \$2000 towards a math resource room; \$2500 towards Indigenous Education program
- -other notable highlights looking to continue to fund Phys Ed and STEM learning
- -if we hit our fundraising goal and our expense goal, we will have a projected balance of \$26 at the end of the school year (July 2025)

#### Vote (among school council members)

- -approval of budget overage for pizza lunch expenses (overage of \$1906): 7 in person; 4 online Passed
- -approval of proposed 2024-2025 budget: 2 online (Jeff and Dima); 6 in person (Teresa, Shannon, Sam, Alison, Tariq, Paula) Pre-approval passed
